Monthly Commission meeting (held via Zoom) - February 9, 2021, 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Klein at 6:32 PM

1. Review and approve January Minutes
 - a. Mark K. shared meetings minutes for review. Austin K. motioned to approve and Nicole W. seconded motion.
2. Review and approve January Financials
 - a. Mark K shared financials for review and reviewed recent expenses/disbursements (quarterly payment to Dixie, overpayment of taxes for a few neighbors, snow removal)
 - b. Next month we should discuss if there are any roads we want to repave this year
 - c. Motion to approve by Austin K. and Nicole W. seconded motion
3. Snow removal feedback
 - a. Switched to Jim Graven and had positive feedback from neighbors
4. Streetlight replacement from HPS to LED
 - a. Neighboring cities have done this recently and had good feedback from residents
 - b. More energy efficient, last longer and brighter
 - c. All in favor of exploring the cost and any other relevant details including when we could start this and how long it would take- Austin K. follow-up with contact at LG&E (Steve Gray) to discuss. *Per email correspondence on 2/11 between commissioners, Leslie B. is going to follow up on this instead of Austin K.*
 - d. Should also inquire about how many lights we currently have and the cost to add more lights in the neighborhood in case this is something we want to do eventually.
5. Food truck Fridays (or another day)
 - a. Have a food truck come Fridays to one of the neighborhood streets and be available for lunch or dinner
 - b. Need to decide on logistics - may make sense to rotate streets for the first month
 - c. Start these late March/early April - would be great to get the first month schedule for these on the next newsletter
 - d. Austin is exploring different truck options - send any ideas/contacts his way
6. Bellewood 'Social' calendar through July
 - a. Yard sale in May - likely Saturday, 5/22 - Mark K. to send email to a couple other neighborhoods we've teamed with in the past to firm up date
 - b. Potential spring scavenger hunt through the neighborhood - likely a Saturday morning
7. Purging old Bellewood documents
 - a. Finn C. confirmed we need to go through the old documents - likely some things we need to keep, including old meeting minutes
 - b. We can go through documents together once we are able to meet in person
