The locations each week will vary to incorporate different streets within Bellewood. I will communicate via email the menu and location each week so that everyone is aware. Please note that the City of Bellewood is not paying for the food like we did for the Ice Cream Social on Halloween. These food trucks each have their own Social Media Pages and advertise on there as well so not only will we see Bellewood residents, we will also see neighbors from other parts of Louisville.

Based on the response from this month, we will see about continuing these on a weekly/monthly basis in the summer.
