Monthly Commission meeting (held in-person at 3919 Brookfield Ave) - April 12, 2022, 6:30 PM

Several neighbors joined for portions of the meeting as described below

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Klein at 6:31 PM

1. Review & approve March minutes
 1. A few changes/corrections to be made
 2. With changes, motion to approve by Mark K. and seconded by Austin K.
2. Review & approve March financials
 1. Will review at the next meeting - awaiting financials from Dixie
3. Fence proposal - The Do's (use/ruling of the easement)
 1. Several neighbors joined the meeting for a discussion around the ownership of the ally between Elmwood & Brookfield
 2. The ally is under the control of Louisville metro vs. the City of Bellewood. Neighbors have been working with Louisville metro to understand next steps should they choose to pursue using the ally property.
 3. There was an ask from some of the residents for the commission to work directly with Louisville metro to close the ally so that all residents can use or not use the property consistently
 4. Mark K. to follow up with Cardinal Survey and Finn C. to follow up with Louisville metro for discussion at the next meeting
4. Drainage issues with 245 Chenoweth Lane
 1. The Edwards joined to discuss the ongoing drainage issues they face after the driveway expansion at 245 Chenoweth Lane
 2. Mark K. called a motion for the property owner of 245 Chenoweth Lane to remove the newly paved areas of the driveway which has caused multiple drainage issues for several neighbors. Finn to send a letter to the property owner citing no approval from the city of Bellewood, Louisville or the state.
 3. Austin K. seconded the motion - commissioners present (Nicole W. Austin K.) voted in favor of the motion
