

### **REACH ALERT**





As the new year is just days away, the Bellewood Commission hopes everyone has had a wonderful holiday season and was able to get through it healthily. Since our last newsletter in October, we successfully hosted our second annual (minus the Covid year) city-wide block party on Brookfield Ave. To say it went well would be an understatement. The turnout was incredible and the neighborly bonding was great to see. We have made notes and have already talked about ways to improve upon this year's party. Thank you to all that helped with setting up, made chili, brought supplies and helped cleanup.

Year two of the leaf pickup has also been completed and I'm happy to report that usage among the city was higher than last year. The feedback from residents to the commission has all been positive and we appreciate everyone's patience as it takes a couple of days for the leaves to come up. We had 85 homes participate each time which tells me that we will continue this service again next Fall.

As we turn the calendar to 2022 in a few days, everyone will be getting one more present in the mailbox. It's that time of year for our Bellewood property tax bills to be paid. The 40% discount is still being offered provided you make your payment before February 28, 2022. Let me know of questions.

Lastly, along with the tax bill envelope coming to your home, there will be a letter attached with it explaining the new **REACH ALERT** that the city will be using for 2022. The goal of this system is to get every home in the city to sign up for alerts so that hand-delivering newsletters, announcements don't need to happen. The alert system will also be useful for the commission to send out messages regarding snow removal updates, leaf removal delays, an accident or fire within the city, etc.
