Monthly Commission meeting (held via Zoom) - March 9, 2021, 6:30 PM

Participants - Mark Klein (Mayor), Austin Kupper (Commissioner), Leslie Beam (Commissioner), Nicole Walton (Commissioner), Doug DeMoss (Commissioner), Finn Cato (Attorney) & Erin Quinnan (City Clerk)

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Klein at 6:31 PM

1. Review and approve February minutes
 1. Mark K. shared meeting minutes for review. Austin K. motioned to approve and Leslie B. seconded motion
2. Review and approve February financials
 1. Mark K. shared and reviewed transactions for February. Snow & ice removal were larger disbursements - exceeded budget by \$250
 2. Regular deposits for the month
 3. Paychecks coming this week for commissioners
 4. Doug D. motioned to approve financials, Nicole W. seconded motion
3. Streetlight replacement update from Leslie B.
 1. We have 27 lights in the neighborhood today
 2. \$7.00 fee per light to switch to LED. It will increase our monthly bill for the next 5 years, but then the cost will go down to around what it is today. Bulbs should last 20-25 years if we switch to LED.
 3. Mark K. asked for motion to approve switch to LED, Austin K. motioned, Leslie B. seconded. Completed roll call for approval from all commissioners and each commissioner approved
 4. Leslie B. to circle back with LG&E to let them know we'd like to make the change
 5. We can also add street lights - cost is \$21 per light
 6. We may consider asking LG&E on recommendation for how many lights we should have in total and then determine how many we want to add
 7. Ask for all commission members to walk the neighborhood at some point and suggest places we may want to consider adding lights
4. Food truck Friday update from Austin K.
 1. All Thai'd Up was the first food truck - did well in terms of sales. They have a \$600 minimum and they had gross sales of \$700 from us

2. Owner of this truck suggested 1 designated spot for trucks each week - ideal would be street that doesn't get as much traffic
 3. Group reviewed upcoming food trucks and locations
5. Garage painting on St. Matthews Ave
 1. Painting was done by Damon Thompson (local artist) and painting is of Tippi Hedren
 2. Discussion with commission members around current ordinances and protocol for exterior artwork. Finn C. to follow up.
6. Ordinance update from American Legal
 1. No major update from Finn C. at this time - still working through codifying
7. In person meeting starting in April
 1. Next meeting potential to have on Mark K.'s back porch - covered and outdoors
 2. Need to post at St. Matthews library where the meetings are being held

Mark K. motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 PM, seconded by Austin K.
